NOTE TO EXHIBITORS

- 👉 **Entries:** Entries will not be accepted without entry fees. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 👉 **Entry Fee:** \$1.00 per entry
- 👉 **Prize Money:** When there is one entry per class ~ First Prize: \$1.00. When there are two or more entries per class ~ First Prize: \$3.00. Second Prize: \$2.00. Prize money will be available after 3pm
- 👉 **Penning:** All birds must be penned by 8.00am Saturday, 9th June 2018
- 👉 **Judging:** Judging shall commence at 8.30am Saturday, 9th June 2018
- 👉 **Presentation of Trophies:** 3.30pm Saturday, Birds can be collected after 4pm

Rules

1. Disease and Vermin infected birds are NOT to be penned. Any birds deemed to be suffering ill health or infected with parasites will be removed from the pavilion.
2. All birds dyed or interfered with will be disqualified.
3. The judge need not award a prize unless it is merited.
4. Water Cups are the responsibility of exhibitors.
5. All matters not specified herein will be dealt with according to QCAS rules.
6. **Junior exhibitors are to be under 15yrs of age and are limited to two entries per exhibitor.**
7. **Ladies exhibitors are limited to two entries per exhibitor but must pen their own entries.**
8. **All Exhibitors attending the show pay the Gate Entrance Fee unless in possession of a Pass.**

Conditions

- 👉 Exhibitors are to state on their entry form the Class number, Breed, Colour or Variety and whether Cock, Hen, Cockerel or Pullet.
- 👉 Judge will be available after judging is completed at his or her discretion.
- 👉 For Champion Junior, points will be awarded ~ 50 for quality and 50 for presentation. If Birds are pure bred it shall be eligible to be judged in the Open Class for Grand Champion Awards.
- 👉 Separate breed classes shall be formed where there are three or more entries of a particular breed or colour to make up such classes, otherwise birds shall be judges as Any Other Variety (AOV) or Any Other Colour (AOC).

1. Standard Soft Feather
2. Standard Hard Feather
3. Bantam Soft Feather
4. Bantam Hard Feather
5. Standard Breeding Pair (1 Female and 1 Male)
6. Bantam Breeding Pair (1 Female and 1 Male)
7. Pair of Females
8. Junior (*bird must be penned by exhibitor*)
9. Ladies (*bird must be penned by breeder*)
