PO Box 219 Toogoolawah 4313. No later than 27th February 2017.
3. **Riders limited to 12 first round runs excluding the Restricted Open (The Committee reserves the right to restrict nominations further in the event of excessive nominations and the availability of cattle)**
4. All riders to ride at their own risk.
5. All horses will be run in order of the draw.
6. Every horse is to be named
7. Judges decision in all cases will be final.
8. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated Campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20.00 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee the \$20.00 is forfeited.
9. Unless otherwise advised competitors can regard their entries as having been accepted, but the Committee shall in no way be responsible for non-receipt of such entries.
10. The decision of the committee on all matters pertaining to the competition shall be final and conclusive and binding on all nominations for the events.
11. In addition, the Committee reserves unto itself the right at any time, without being liable for any loss or damage which may be sustained, to alter or postpone that date of events, or cancel the same or to change the venue of the events.
12. In order to procure sufficient cattle ALL NOMINATIONS to be in writing with horses name, and FULLY PAID to the secretary by 27th Feb. 2017. No late nominations will be accepted.
13. Nominations will be refunded in full if notified 5 days prior to draft.
14. Scratching's 7 days prior to 8am of draft (return 100%); then can keep \$15; then 3 days prior to 8am of draft (keep 100%)
15. Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and be securely fastened under the chin.
16. All competitors must be a member of the ACA as per the recent ACA ruling for affiliated camp drafts. ACA membership season is 1st April – 31st March 2017
17. All horses must have accompanying Horse Health Declaration.
